Brownland Farm is a lovely, quiet, open air venue. All Young Horse classes will be held outdoors in open arenas on both days. Plenty of warm up and plenty of shade.

This facility requires a Health Certificate issued within 7 days of arrival on the grounds.

LEVELS: USDF Introductory through FEI Grand Prix, current editions

AWARDS: Award (in classes of three or more) and six ribbons.

Master's Classes: Register in awards office for High Point award. Open to entries in which the combined ages of Horse & Rider equal at least 65 years on the date of the class. Riders are responsible for signing up in awards area. Award will be given for “Express” and “The Tennessean”.

USDF/Dover Saddlery Adult Amateur Medal: First place Adult Amateur in classes#123 and #223 (minimum score of 60%).

Jockey Club Thoroughbred Incentive Program (T.I.P.) will award High Point ribbons for the following levels/tests: Introductory, Training, Third Level, PSG, Intermediate, Grand Prix and Over all High Point Thoroughbred. Only Thoroughbreds that have been registered with The Jockey Club or a foreign Thoroughbred stud book recognized by The Jockey Club are eligible to participate in the T.I.P Awards. Riders and owners should obtain a T.I.P number for all horse/rider combinations. T.I.P. numbers applications are done online at www.tjctip.com. T.I.P. numbers must be provided

Special Awards and Breed Awards: Check www.tndressage.com for updated list. Bring copy of proof of eligibility (registration papers and/or membership cards) to **awards** office at check-in and fill out special award entry form.

Tennessean and Express Dressage Awards : High Score for each Level and Division, Intro through Fourth Level. High score FEI for each Division. (Does not include Freestyle at any Level.)

ENTRIES: State “qualifying” where applicable. GAIG/USDF qualifying entries must include copy of USEF and USDF horse registration cards.

<http://www.eqverification.org/> is an excellent site to print USEF / USDF card copies for horses, riders and owners all on one page...no photocopying necessary. Riders who are not US citizens please include a copy of foreign competitors license or USEF Card. **EACH ENTRY MUST** include all required documentation. For on line entries follow the instructions. GUEST HORSE: Non Competing horses are welcome. Send a completed entry form and \$25 user fee plus \$35.00 Office fee. Submit a current Coggins and pay either stabling or day parking. When warm up areas and lunging areas are busy give way to competing horses or come back at a less crowded time.

MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE to “CTDA” and mail with entry, USDF/USEF documents and copy of negative Coggins to Entry Secretary. Entries must be received by the closing date. Be sure to waive ALL signature requirements on mailed/expressed entries. Secretary is not always in office to sign for mail. Entries received after closing date will be placed on a waiting list. If accepted a late fee will apply.

ON LINE ENTRIES are through: www.equestrianentries.com . Fees for online entries are \$5.00 handling and 3%of entry total to pay credit card charges. This is also your source for legible, “mistake proof” typed entries even if you do not choose to pay by credit card through them. First time users can get \$5.00 off your first paid online entry submission by putting the following Coupon Code in the payment section: **FIRSTENTRY**. Record your info and print out an entry form and mail with check if you choose. If you pay by check the service is free. Scores will be live streamed to Fox Village Website.

Refunds: Before closing date full refund, less office fee. No refunds after closing date, including cancellation of classes due to inclement weather. “No Shows” will be considered scratches and time slots may be filled.

Returned check policy: Void entry and incur a \$25 charge. Entries placed on a waiting list until a money order, certified check or cash is received.

REFUNDS: Before closing date full refund, less office fee. After closing date: no refund. No refund for cancellation due to Act of God. *Tennessee law requires the original negative Coggins (drawn within 12 months of the show) be presented to the show*

secretary when picking up competition packets.

STABLING: *Put all stabling information and \$\$ on the EXPRESS Entry if you are entering both shows.*

Permanent 10 X 10 stalls, with half doors. Aisles must not be blocked with hay or equipment. Barns have wash racks. Additional feed and shavings available for purchase upon arrival at the facility. Order additional bedding in advance and it will be at your stall upon arrival.

Groups specify ONE NAME to coordinate group stabling.

ARENAS: . Competition: 20 X 60 meters, Three outdoor. Footing is sand mix. Warm-up: outdoor warm-up, separate area for lunging. Outdoor rings are sand/mix. Rings open for schooling Friday until 7pm weather permitting. Warm up arenas are available at all times.

TIMES: Official times posted Friday, June 6th at show office. Unofficial times posted Monday at www.TNDressage.com. Acknowledgements will be emailed. Please include LEGIBLE email addresses and telephone number on entry form.

ACCOMODATIONS: HOST HOTEL: Sleep Inn at Moores Lane Exit. Accepts pets. 615-376-2122. Many national chains at I-65 exit Cool Springs. Sleep Inn, Marriot Courtyard, Residence Inn, Wingate, Hyatt and others at nearby exits. All are about 10 minutes from the facility. Book Early. This is a busy time around Nashville and Shelbyville.

DIRECTIONS: From Nashville the South on I-65 take Exit 68B for Cool Springs Blvd. West. Merge onto Cool Springs and go 1.5 miles. Turn right onto TN397 N—Mack C.Hatcher Memorial Parkway. Go 2.5 miles and turn right onto Hillsboro Road. Go .3 miles. Brownland Farms is on your left.

HOSPITALITY: Concessions (Good Food) available on grounds.

OPPORTUNITY CLASSES: These classes are exempt from required USEF and USDF fees for horse, rider, trainer, etc. Entries in opportunity classes may ONLY cross enter into Introductory classes.

OTHER: Facility Management requires all mounted riders to wear an approved helmet. Facility requires 7 day health certificate.
